- ADRIFT HOTEL Start your #wanderbybike adventure!
- B PICKLED FISH Adrift's onsite restaurant with views of the Pacific Ocean, live music, craft cocktails, microbrews and New American cuisine. Brunch 8am-2pm / Provisions 2-4pm / Dinner 4-9pm / Late Night 9pm-close
- ORLD KITE MUSEUM & HALL OF FAME In the 1980s, enthusiasts formed a non-profit dedicated to kite flying. The current iteration of the museum opened in 2005 and showcases 1500 kites from 26 countries. \$5 admission. 11am-5pm
- WORLD'S LARGEST FRYING PAN Public art in the form of a replica of a real, cast iron skillet that was created for the clam festival of 1941 where a woman strapped bacon onto her feet and "ice skated" the skillet.
- E CRANBERRY MUSEUM SW Washington enjoys over 100 years in cranberry farming. Take in some of the 40 acres of bogs on a self-guided walking tour. Apr-Dec 10am-5pm
- PNORTH JETTY BREWING Local craft brewery serving IPA, Scottish Ale, Porter, Weissbier and more! W-Th 3-9pm / F-Sa 2-10pm / Su 2-7pm
- G NORTH HEAD LIGHTHOUSE Once called the "Graveyard of the Pacific", the Columbia River's mouth needed a second lighthouse (first was Cape Disappointment) to serve as primary navigation for ships. Thus, the North Head was built in 1898. Tours offered during the summer for \$2.50.
- CAPE DISAPPOINTMENT One of the foggiest places in the U.S., the Cape edures the equivalent of 106 days of fog annually.
